ISDS Professor Awarded CSU's Highest Honor

Zvi Drezner, professor of information systems and decision sciences, is one of five recipients of the prestigious California State University Wang Family Excellence Award. Drezner, renowned for his teaching and research, was selected from universities throughout the 23-campus CSU system. He will receive a cash award of \$20,000 and will be recognized along with the 4 other recipients at the Trustees meeting in May.

"I'm overwhelmed," said Drezner, who added that he was elated to be so honored, and thanked the "Wang family and the California State University for their generous support."

A member of the faculty since 1985, Drezner's research, methods and models have been recognized by peers throughout the world. He was honored in 2005 with the Lifetime Achievement in Location Analysis Award from the Institute for Operations Research and the Management Sciences, and received Cal State Fullerton's Outstanding Professor Award in 2006. ■
