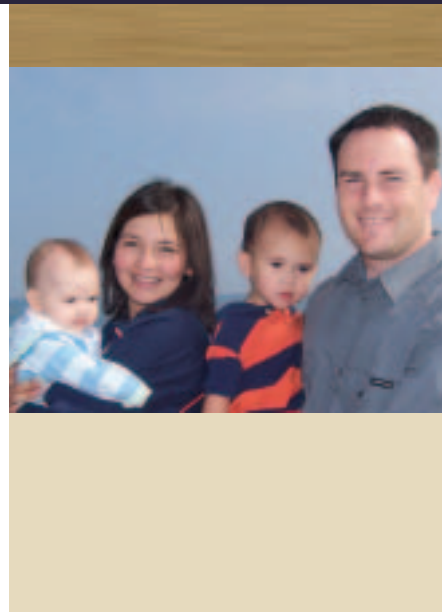
Prior to Baker Hughes, Jim served four years in the United States Air Force.
