Up to Two Tenure-Track Positions**

The Department of Economics at the Mihaylo College of Business and Economics at California State University, Fullerton invites applications for one (possibly two) full-time tenure-track positions in the field of Applied Macroeconomics using time series analysis as applied to financial markets and financial data. Lecturer positions may also be available.

Successful candidates must demonstrate a research and teaching ability in applied time series macroeconomics with emphasis on financial markets, financial institutions, or macro finance. We are particularly interested in candidates whose research focuses on the interactions between monetary/fiscal policy and financial markets or the link between the macroeconomy and financial markets. Faculty are expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in this area.

Position

Responsibilities of faculty include publications in quality peer-review journals, quality teaching of undergraduate and graduate courses, as well as service work at the Departmental/College/University levels.

Qualifications

Candidates for the position must:

- Possess a Ph.D. by the start of appointment;
- Have research potential as evidenced by research papers or a record of publication and ongoing research;
- Demonstrate effectiveness in teaching; and
- Possess the ability to interact effectively with a wide and culturally diverse range of students and colleagues.

Rank and Salary

The tenure-track position(s) is at the rank of Assistant Professor. Salary is commensurate to rank, experience and qualifications of the applicant.
