Subject: Urgent - CSUF Fall 2011 Fee Increase

To FEMBA (Irvine) Students,

As you may know from press reports, on July 12, 2011 the California State University Board of Trustees voted to increase tuition fees for the Fall 2011 term for a second time as part of an overall budget action plan. This results in an additional 12% increase in state-support tuition fees. The compounded state-support increase is 23%.

CSU Fullerton is doing everything it can to minimize the impact on students but the reduction of support from state funding will not be undetected. Although the FEMBA (Irvine) program is classified as a “self-support” program, it does rely upon a number of services and infrastructure that is used by all operations at CSUF. In order to continue to provide these services and infrastructure, the fee structure of this program must increase.

This letter is to inform you that the per course fee for your cohort in the FEMBA (Irvine) program will increase to \$2,100 per course beginning in Fall 2011 semester. If you have registered and paid your fees, there is a balance in your account now, and you will receive a notification of balance due either via phone or email from us.

All students that presently receive or are interested in financial aid are encouraged to complete the FAFSA (www.fafsa.org) and work with the CSUF Student Financial Services office (<http://sfs.fullerton.edu/>).
