The **Business Student Advisory Board** aims to enhance the educational experience of students in the College of Business and Economics while serving as a consulting group for the Dean, administrators, faculty and staff. The Board will support decision-making for the College and act as a liaison between College officials and the business student body.

Eligibility (subject to change):

- Currently enrolled business student major and a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Ability to serve for one academic year and attend five Friday meetings per semester along with two days of professional development
- Provide a minimum of one reference form
 - o Forms must be from non-relatives Professor, College of Business and Economics staff, peer, present or past employer, etc. No forms from relatives; parents, siblings, etc.

- 2. Selection of board members will occur during the Spring 2024 semester.
- 3. Selected students will attend a mandatory orientation/professional development session.
- 4. Meetings will commence in the Fall 2024 semester and end in the Spring 2025 semester. Meetings will be held on Fridays, tentative dates will be provided in the offer letter.
