

Finance – Corporate Finance

If you have an interest in both finance and accounting, you may want to consider pursuing a career in corporate finance. Finance departments usually carry out four main activities to meet their objectives:

- 1) designing, implementing and monitoring financial policies
- 2) planning and executing the financing program
- 3) managing cash resources
- 4) interfacing with the financial community and investors

Your role would be to create value for the company. Whether you have a strong background in accounting and want to transition to a finance career, have a dual concentration in both areas, or are interested in working in an internal finance role at a company, corporate finance may be the career path for you!



Corporate finance roles often do not have a definitive position name. Some titles may sound more accounting-based, thus it is important to pay attention to the job descriptions, which will detail the duties that fall under finance and/or accounting. Sometimes, the role may be in another department, such as operations where you would support the finance function of the company. These roles may be a great way to get your foot in the door and prepare you for a transition or promotion into a corporate finance role.
