

Accounting – Private & Corporate



Private accountants are individuals who work in the accounting department of a company as staff accountants, cost accountants, or internal auditors. While public accountants who provide services for individual clients, private accountants conduct the accounting services for an entire company.

Staff accountants setup systems and record business transactions that are combined into financial statements. They also set budgets, manage assets, track payroll, make accounts payable and receivable, and manage other financial matters.

Internal auditors provide objective assurance and consulting activity that adds value and improves an organization's operations. Internal auditors ensure a company's compliance with policies, procedures, and laws by monitoring, assessing, and analyzing organizational risk and controls by reviewing and confirming information.

Cost accountants collect, analyze, summarize and evaluate alternative courses of action. Their goal is to advise management on the most appropriate course of action based on cost efficiency and capability.
